The recovery period will be quite long. To ensure we hopefully miss any winter weather, we have rescheduled our trip to arrive in the U.S. 26 April and leave on 23 July 2018. There were quite a few fund-raising events that were already planned for October and November. Because there was so much work already put into the events, the events will still go on without us. We're very grateful for this, as we need extra funds for our new school year that starts in January.
