With this work, we'll see a decrease in our electric bill and improved safety in general.

Micky's sister Debbie has been here for 6 weeks and has another 5 weeks with us. The computer lab is well under way. The older kids have begun Typing lessons, and the younger kids are benefiting from math and English games. There are still a couple of computers still needing a little work TLC. Our friend Michael Calamia from A World Aware has been a huge help in getting some of the computers to act right, in addition to a friend of ours in St Louis, helping answer questions through e-mail. The children are already getting computer time.



Still no word on Micky's visa. If we don't get an answer in the next two months, she has to leave the country and come back for another 90 days.
