Charles, our headmaster was key in this, as he had them out in the evenings and even in the early mornings practicing for the running, and had them dig a trench and build their own long jump pit, so they could practice.



Philip and Retha's son Dawid spent exactly one month in the hospital recovering from



his snake bite. In the end, he lost his ring finger on his left hand, but his life was saved. It could have been so much worse. He is recovering at home now and goes back to the hospital once a week for wound check and redressing. He has been a very brave boy. The bills were enormous, but we have an enormous God. At this stage, all of the bills have been covered. He still has more recovery and therapy to go. Everyone was very excited to have him back home, and he was more than ready to get out of the hospital. We and the family are so deeply grateful for the outpouring of love, prayers, and financial support. We can't thank you enough.
